“Sukhdevji Maharaj of Saongi Memorial Scholarship” is awarded every year to the meritorious Undergraduate students. The scholarship consists of a GOLD MEDAL and cash prize of more than 1,00,000/- rupees.

The scholarship is applicable to students who have passed B. Sc. examination

The scholarship will be awarded to students from undergraduate programs (who have passed B.Sc in summer) with the following subjects:

- 1. Chemistry**
- 2. Physics**
- 3. Botany**
- 4. Zoology**
- 5. Statistics**
- 6. Mathematics.**

1. To be eligible for the scholarship, a student should have secured at least 60% marks at the graduate examination and studied all the three years in Institute of Science only.
2. The concerned student should not have cleared any previous /current examination using ATKT rules or grace marks.
3. The concerned student must have passed the examination in first attempt itself.
4. A student securing the highest marks in each of the six subjects mentioned above at the B.Sc I,II and III examinations taken together will be awarded the scholarship. i.e there will be six medals and an equal number of cash prizes for each of the six subjects. A student may bag a medal (and cash prize) in more than one subject.
5. To be considered for the scholarship, the eligible student **will necessarily have to apply in the prescribed format available in the Dept.of Statistics// office (scholarship section)**
6. If an eligible student fails to apply , he/she will not be considered for the scholarship.

INSPIRE Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria

INSPIRE Scholarship aims to enhance rates of attachment of talented youth to undertake higher education in science intensive programmes, by providing scholarships and mentorship. The scheme offers 10,000 Scholarship every year at Rs 0.80 lakh per year for the talented youth in the age group 17-22 years, for undertaking Bachelor and Masters level education in natural sciences. The main feature of the scheme is the mentorship support provided to every scholar.

1. **The student must be in Top 1%** in their respective Board Exams.

2. The student pursuing three years B.Sc., B.Sc (Hons), four years B.S.

Five years integrated M.Sc./M.S programs in any UGC recognized College/ University/ Institutions in India in natural/basic sciences.

(OR)

Top 10,000 Ranks in National Competitive Exams

Students who have secured in the Joint Entrance Examination of the following exams. They have also opted to study Natural and Basic sciences in any academic institute or university leading to graduate and post-graduate degree.

- JEE Advanced [Top 10,000 ranks].
- JEE Main [Top 10,000 Ranks].
- AIPMT [Top 10,000 Ranks].

3. The **INSPIRE** Scholarship is also open to all **KVPY, NTSE, JBNSTS scholars and Science Olympiad Medalists**.

4. Opting to undertake courses in the Natural & Basic sciences leading to B.Sc. And M.Sc. degrees.

5. The Applicant can not avail any other Scholarships.

6. The Subjects under the Basic and Natural Sciences within the scope of **INSPIRE Scholarship** for pursuing B. Sc course:

Mathematics, Biology, Statistics, Geology, Astrophysics, Astronomy, Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, Botany, Zoology, Biochemistry, Anthropology, Atmospheric Sciences & Oceanic Sciences, Microbiology, Geophysics, Geochemistry.
