Various activities have been conducted throughout the year under WDC, the details of which are as follows

1. Inauguration of WDC (18th August 2023): The formal inauguration of the Women's Development Cell (WDC) took place on 18th August 2023, alongside other committees of the Institute of Science. 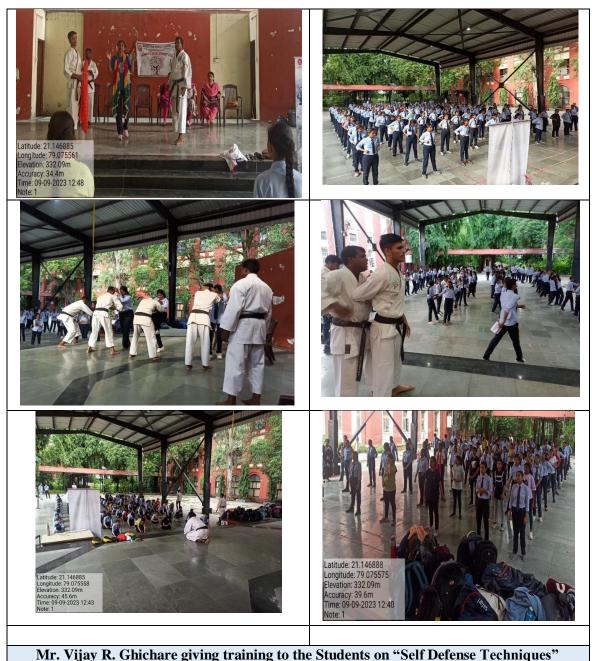








2. One-Day Workshop on "Self-Defense Techniques" (8th September 2023): The Women's Development Cell, in collaboration with the Department of Physical Education, organized a one-day workshop on Self-Defense Techniques on 8th September 2023. The session was led by Mr. Vijay R. Ghichare, a 4th Dan Black Belt in Karate, along with his team from the Vidarbha Karate Association, Nagpur. The workshop began with an orientation and discussion on safety precautions in various environments, including roads, homes, workplaces, and public spaces. The trainer demonstrated several self-defense techniques designed to enhance self-confidence and informed participants on how everyday items like handbags, keychains, and dupattas can be used effectively as safety tools.

- 3. The topics covered were:
 - 1. **Science and Superstitions:** Experts from MANS, an organization dedicated to raising awareness about superstitions, shared their knowledge with the students. They demonstrated how common superstitions can be debunked using scientific principles and discussed ways to prevent the spread of misleading information.

- 2. **Plastic-Free Campus:** Dr. Nagesh Yemul, a faculty member of the Botany department, addressed the harmful effects of plastic on the environment and human health. He emphasized the importance of maintaining a plastic-free campus to safeguard both nature and life.
- 3. **Physical and Mental Hygiene:** Guest Speaker Mrs. Revati Deshpande delivered an insightful lecture on the significance of maintaining both physical and mental hygiene. She highlighted the crucial role hygiene plays in overall well-being and encouraged students to prioritize it in their daily lives.

3. Guest Lecture by Dr. Pratibha Bhutange on "Bharatiya Rajyaghatana Ani Samajik Kayade" & "Yoga Health and Wellness" (28th February 2024):

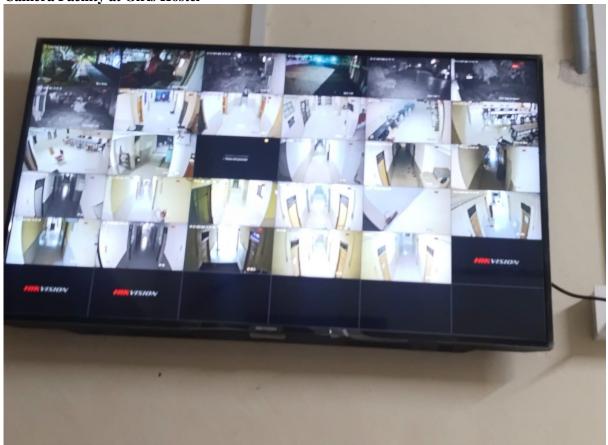

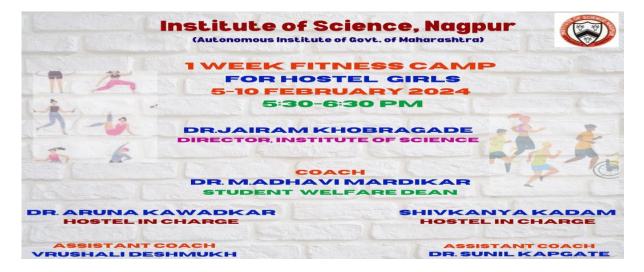
